Bell-Park has received notice today from Olive Grass CO., LTD. (President & CEO: Kento Nishikawa) that the company has acquired shares of Bell-Park from Mr. Takeru Nishikawa, Chairman & CEO of Bell-Park.

As a result of this share transfer, Olive Grass CO., LTD. has newly become a major shareholder, the largest shareholder, and another affiliated company of Bell-Park. Consequently, Mr. Takeru Nishikawa is no longer a major shareholder or the largest shareholder of Bell-Park.

Consequently, Olive Grass CO., LTD. is newly classified as an unlisted other affiliated company subject to disclosure as a parent or equivalent company.
